1 Diary, Jan van Riebeeck Krotoa, called Eva by the Dutch, is the first Khoikhoi woman to appear in the European records of the early settlement at the Cape as an individual personality and active participant in cultural and economic exchange. Eva joined Commander Jan van Riebeeck's household at the Dutch fort at around age 12.

He was later sent to the Cape to set up a half-way station for people travelling to the East. He arrived with his wife, Maria and baby son on the 6th April 1652.
